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Curricular area	Suggested activities	Online links or SeeSaw task
Literacy – Reading	<ul> <li>Choose a story from home or scan one from the book list &amp; read it with a family member.</li> <li>Chat about the key features of a story – author, illustrator, blurb &amp; a character</li> </ul>	
Literacy – Spelling	<ul> <li>Practise writing the months of year. Have a go at writing in an interesting way e.g. rainbow writing, playdough/magnetic letters or bubble writing.</li> <li>Design a wordsearch on a topic of your choice e.g. animals Use a dictionary/computer to check your spelling. Give someone the wordsearch to complete! Try <a href="https://thewordsearch.com/maker/">https://thewordsearch.com/maker/</a></li> </ul>	
Literacy – Writing	<ul> <li>Help an adult write a list for the shopping.</li> <li>Choose 1 of your favourite books and design a new front cover for it. Remember to include the tittle, author &amp; a picture.</li> </ul>	
Numeracy & Maths	<ul> <li>Go on a shape hunt in your house / garden. Can you write a list or draw a picture of what you found?</li> <li>Design a number diary. Fold a sheet of paper and give your diary a front cover with a title e.g. 'Super Numbers'. Choose a different number for each page &amp; write about where you've seen the number e.g. it's my house number, on the TV. You may even want to cut &amp; stick examples from magazines/catalogues or draw pictures.</li> </ul>	
Health & Wellbeing	<ul> <li>Draw someone in your life as a superhero. Design a costume for them and describe their superpower.</li> <li>Have a go at making a fruit salad. Can you draw a picture of what you did or upload a photo to your Seesaw?</li> </ul>	
Other areas: IDL/STEM	<ul> <li>STEM creativity challenge! What can you do with a cereal box?</li> <li>Design a poster to encourage people to pick up litter. Use books/internet for ideas. Make sure your poster has a title &amp; an interesting picture.</li> </ul>
