







Self- Isolation – Home Learning

Curricular area	Suggested activities	Online links or SeeSaw task
Literacy – Reading 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Choose a story from home or scan one from the book list and read it with a family member.Practise singing your favourite nursery rhyme. Can you make some actions to go with the rhyme?	
Literacy – Spelling 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Try playing I-Spy with someone in your family.Have-a-go- at the Alphabet Game. Choose a topic such as animals and then try to name an animal for each letter of the alphabet.	
Literacy – Writing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Draw a picture of character from your favourite book. Can you write their name too?Play the Name Game. Can you write your name in big writing, small writing or rainbow writing (different colours)?	
Numeracy & Maths 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Go on a number hunt, either in the house or garden. Chat to a family member about the numbers you find e.g. house numbers, bus numbers, page numbers, TV controller etc.Practise making patterns in different ways e.g. Lego, stones, books etc. Can you continue a pattern made by someone else?	
Health & Wellbeing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Our school values are Honesty, Respect, Responsibility & Fairness. Can you draw a picture or take a photo of you showing 1 of these values? Can you explain what the value means?Help to make a yummy snack for all your family to enjoy. Can you share a photo or drawing of what you did?	
Other areas: IDL/STEM 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Build your own blanket den and enjoy some 'chill time'. Take a photo upload it to your Seesaw.Create some outdoor art. Collect some leaves and do some crayon rubbings or use sticks/stones/leaves etc create a face. Be as creative as you like!
